



## BONUS: Intermediate Slow Left-Hand Pattern

This lesson is an intermediate one about the left-hand pattern when chords last for two beats or more.

**6. Arpeggio Pattern:** The left hand plays the root note of the chord, followed by the fifth of the chord, and the root again but up higher. The pattern continues upwards, using the third, fifth and another root note before descending to the fifth and third. Arpeggio is an Italian word for harp like.

### PATTERN IN 4/4 TIME:

RH	C	/	/	/
LH	C G C E	G C G E		

Fingering is important on this pattern:

RH	C	/	/	/
LH	C G C E	G C G E		
	5 2 1 3	2 1 2 3		

### PATTERN IN 3/4 TIME:

Note: We can still use this pattern in 3/4 time. We will use the ascending notes only, then stop.

RH	C	/	/
LH	C G	C E	G C
	5 2	1 3	2 1

Use the arpeggio pattern on each chord in the left hand. Remember, you can use your arpeggio any time you have 2 of the same chords in a row (Ex. C / ). Note: For now, focus on using this pattern on major and minor chords only.
